

RESOLUTION #2026-02: A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF SANDERSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING ITS DISPOSAL THROUGH DONATION TO OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCY

WHEREAS, from time to time the City will have personal property that becomes obsolete, broken, or worn out, and is replaced by newer equipment, or is no longer necessary for city operations; and

WHEREAS, said personal property must be disposed of according to OCGA 36-37-6, in order to recoup any salvage value; and

WHEREAS, the City Department Heads have recommended that the attached list of equipment be declared surplus property and be disposed of through donation to other government agency., or, for items holding no value, by disposal whereby the Mayor and City Council wish to do so;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandersville, Georgia this 17th day of February, 2026 as follows:

Section 1. The property listed on the attached spreadsheet from the Chief of Police and reviewed by the City Manager is hereby declared surplus and is authorized to be disposed of through donation, or as disposal deemed appropriate by the Finance Director.

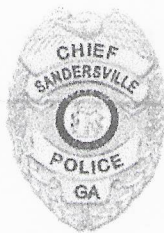
Section 2. This Resolution shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its date of adoption.

Surplus Property

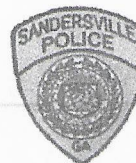
The Sandersville Police Department is requesting to surplus and donate it's supply of Axon Taser 7 Energy Devices to smaller agencies in need of equipment.

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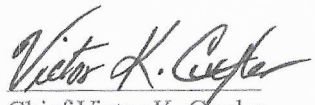
